Producer Outi has worked professionally in films since 1985. She has produced & co-produced some 50 films. Keep on dancing by Agnieszka Zwiefka, produced by Katarzyna Slesicka & Anna Stylowa, My Way Studio (Poland) with Heino Deckert, ma.ja.de (Germany) for HBO, Yle and RUV (sales Deckert Distribution). In 2021 premiered the documentary Raise the Bar by Gudjon Ragnarsson, with Margret Jonasdottir, Saga Film (EDDAN award 'Best Documentary 2022', ECFA Best European Documentary for Young audience 2022, sales Cats&Docs).

Outi's films have been screened and awarded in international and domestic forums, 8 State film prize and 12 JUSSI (Finnish Oscar) nominations, 2 JUSSI awards and 1 EDDAN award, 2 EDDA nominations. A co-production RAISE THE BAR awarded The Best European Documentary film for children and young people in 2022 by ECFA (European Childrens' Film Association). Outi awarded 'Little Bear' prize in 2008 for her work for improving childrens' film culture in Finland. Her special interest is films for younger audience. She attends yearly the film events and forums, such as IDFA, Nordisk Panorama and MBrane.

Outi is an EAVE graduate (1997) and film producer of Art Academy TAIK (1996). She has studied in international film workshops since 1994, such as CineKid ScriptLAB (2021-2022), **DOK.Incubator** (2019) editing and marketing workshop of documentaries, **SOURCES2** script workshops (2002&2008), SOURCES TrainingMentors (2015) and in other workshops on coproduction, script writing, film distribution and marketing.

In 2014-2019 Outi was a film commissioner for documentaries & shorts at <u>AVEK</u> and in 1997-2001 a member of the **National Cinema Council**, the expert body for the Ministry of Education & Culture. Outi is a chair of the board of **DocPoint Documentary film** association and she overlooks the activities and development of the **DocPoint** film festival, **DOKKINO** and DocPoint **IMPACT** (www.docpoint.fi). She is also a board member of <u>AGMA</u> – Agents and Managers of Creative Industries and <u>Arts Promotion Centre</u>, which is an expert body of Ministry of Culture & Education.
